October 7, 1960

Children depart for their families.

November 8, 1960

Arrival of Fr. Mulvihill from the Ottawa Commission.

November 9, 1960

Mulvihill left for Cluny at 2:24 p.m.

November 10, 1960

Children with their families. Parade of the medical corps.

December 22, 1960

Christmas concert given by the children. Many people, many parents too.

December 23, 1960

Departure of the children for their vacations.

January 4, 1961

Classes start again.

February 2, 1961

Mr. Shank, educator, comes to visit the school.

February 9, 1961

Cadet parade. Medical Corps in Ponoka. Our Pee-Wee in Quebec City lost 5-4 in overtime.

February 27, 1961

Cadet and Medical Corps Parade.

March 10, 1961

Open House. Education week. Parents come in large numbers: 200.

March 13, 1961

Mr. Oldring comes to inspect the books.

March 30, 1961

Children go to their families.

April 5, 1961

Visit from Educationalist Schank. Visit of a group of students.

April 9, 1961

The children return from their vacation.

May 18, 1961

Inspection of the Cadets. Very successful.

May 19, 1961

Children go on weekend.

May 22, 1961

Children return.

May 26, 1961

The 4-H meets. Nice demonstration.

May 28, 1961

Scouts - Cubs - Guides and Brownies go to Edmonton. General meeting. C. de C. Banquet.

June 7, 1961

Some Girl Scouts receive ranks.

June 8, 1961

Medical Corps parade in Ponoka and inspection.

June 9, 1961

Children's picnic. Very beautiful day started with a high mass in honor of the Sacred Heart.

June 11, 1961

Father Voisin says the four o'clock mass for the graduates of the XII & IX grades. Father Paradis sings the 10:30 a.m. high mass and says the 8:00 p.m. mass. Banquet for graduates and parents and teachers. Mr. Jess gives a masterly speech. Meeting with parents.

June 12, 1961

90 children went to CFRN TV for a demonstration.

June 23, 1961

Kenneth Wolfe leaves for Magog for music camp.
Departure of Grades X & XI.

June 30, 1961

Departure of the children. End of classes.

September 4, 1961

The children arrive in good numbers.

September 11, 1961

Fr. Voisin goes with Kenneth Wolfe, Daniel Little Child, Sister Jeanne-de-Chantal, to record a program at C. F. R. N. T. V. Departure at 5:30.

September 27, 1961

Two people from the University of Alberta come to record a "School broadcast" program.

October 26, 1961

Inspector Gooderham and Shank here.

November 4, 1961

Children leave for the first time.

June 12, 1961

P. Provincial changed the high mass of graduation and preached to the children. Banquet at 1 p. m. In addition to the graduates, 2 in Gr XII, 13 in IX and the 4 graduates of the Western Board of Music, there are parents, teachers, Fr. Provincial, Inspector Massing and his wife, Mr. Olsen, Inspector, Fr. Meeting after the banquet. Very nice party.

June 15, 1961

Reception of the " Badges " for Guides and Brownies at 8:00. Some parents.

November 25, 1961

Kenneth Wolfe begins his violin lessons in Edmonton accompanied by two Sisters.

December 8, 1961

Immaculate Conception. [... ...] Parades of all groups before mass. Singing by the girls - very good songs. Big banquet. Social evening ...

December 11, 1961

Cadet officers here. Parade of cadets & army.

December 19, 1961

Soldiers from the medical group in Ponoka along with eight girls for folk dances.

December 20, 1961

Children's concert for the children.

December 21, 1961

Concert for parents and friends. Mr. Keskly and Ray Thomas.

December 22, 1961

Children's departure at 2 p.m.

January 3, 1962

Children return to school.

January 15, 1962

Dr. MacDonald here on the morning of the 15th. He inspects the children's eyes.

February 9, 1962

The children give their concert at Merca Glen. Perfect success. The people are very pleased.

March 16, 1962

"Open House" at the school. A large number of parents visited the classrooms. All are very satisfied. Many expressed their appreciation.

March 26, 1962

Medical Corps inspection & cadet parade.

March 27-28, 1962

[Farewell meeting and celebrations for the departure of Father G. M. Latour].
