Data in the columns above indicate the existence of census records, death certificates, and other documents for the 48 children named on the National Centre For Truth and Reconciliation's (NCTR) Memorial Register as having died while registered at the Mohawk Institute. The data establish that these students are not 'missing'. In 75% of cases there is documentary evidence of their place of death, and in almost 50% of cases there is documentary evidence of their place of burial. In 71% of cases the cause of death is documented, and in 50% of cases there is documentary evidence that they received professional medical care. In 27% of cases there is documentary evidence that family members were involved during the student's final illness and burial. In 37% of cases documents sent to Ottawa concerning the child's illness and/or death have survived. Only 9 students actually died on the premises of the Mohawk Institute. The others died elsewhere.

For 9 students, Peter Doctor, Walter Henry, Stanley Herkimer, Sarah Hill, Susannah Maracle, Mary Ann Suzan Clara Ottereyes, Loretta Sero, Morley Snake, and Francis Waddilove, there is no documentary evidence that the child was ever a student at any school much less that the child died at the Mohawk Institute. These 9 names represents almost one-fifth of the 48 names on the NCTR's list. If the NCTR has evidence that these 9 children ever attended the Mohawk Institute, it should produce it.
