Column G: Remains of Stanley Setah found 8 years after death; buried 1979

Column H: Errors include incorrect spelling of names, wrong dates of death in NCTR list

In this spreadsheet the order of the NCTR list has been retained so that names in the spreadsheet can easily be checked against the NCTR list, but the surname has been placed first so that the list can also be sorted by surname if desired.
