Column E: BC=BC death record; DIA=Department of Indian Affairs Annual Report; I=Department of Indian Affairs inquiry into student death (1948);

QR=Library and Archives Canada School Files Series quarterly return (1943-1949)

Column G: Burials in Indian reserve cemeteries unless otherwise specified

Column H: Errors include incorrect spelling of names, wrong dates of death in NCTR list

NOTE: Thomas Mason's death certificate states he was 20 years old, married, and a fisherman. Samson Edgar's death certificate states he was 21 years old and a fisherman.
